TRADITIONAL LONG-TERM ACUTE CARE (LTAC)

Long-term Acute Care (LTAC) is recommended for those who require complex medical management and therapeutic care – 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, with daily assessment of the patient by a physician.

PERSONS REQUIRING TRADITIONAL LONG-TERM ACUTE CARE ARE GENERALLY:

- Admitted from an acute care hospital setting and often directly admitted from the ICU.
- Medically and physically compromised with multi-system complications and/or failures that require hospitalization.
- In need of extended acute care (average 25 days or more), but have the potential for recovery and may then transition home or to the next level of care.
